The children have been busy exploring cause and effect in class. They have been using the guttering to make balls run faster and in class they have now built their very own rocket!



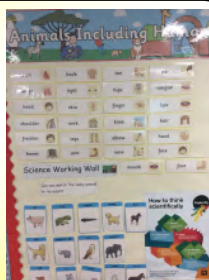
Foundation 2

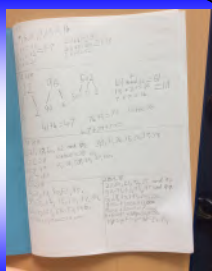
Year 2

Year 2 had an excellent basketball session, during which they were improving their passing and dribbling skills. With support from Pelican Park they all had a great lesson. Well done!



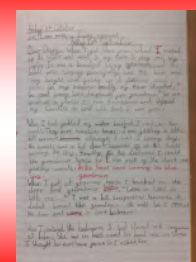
Year 3

Year 3 are working really hard to improve their Big Maths. Lessons are fast paced and full of arithmetic and the children are doing a great job. Keep working on those tables!



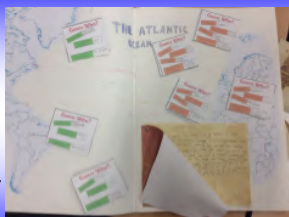
Year 4
