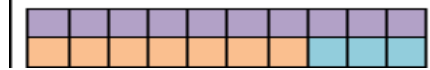

Below is a character description of Vlad the Flea from one of Yls favourite texts: Vlad and the Great Fire of London.

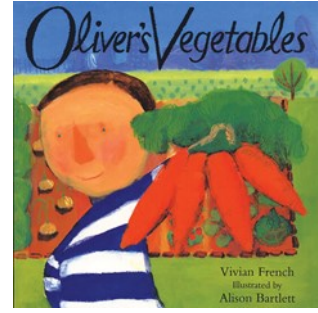
Vlad lives on a rat called Boxton.
