The 2018 Winter Olympics

The 2018 Winter Olympics are taking place between February 9th and 25th. The venue for this thrilling festival of snow and ice-based sports is PyeongChang in South Korea.

Athletes will be competing for 102 medals in seven different sports -biathlon, bobsleigh, curling, ice hockey, luge, skating and skiing. As is traditional at Olympics, some new events will be introduced. These are Big Air Snowboarding, Freestyle Skiing, Mass Start Speed Skating and Mixed Doubles Curling.

This is the 23rd Winter Olympic Games, but it's the first time it has taken place in Korea.

PyeongChang is about 80 miles east of the Korean capital, Seoul, which hosted the summer Olympics in 1988. It's a case of third time lucky for PyeongChang, after failed bids in 2010 and 2014. It beat off stiff competition from Munich in Germany and Annecy in France -but it's no surprise why it's an ideal location for winter sports lovers. Located high in the mountains, the temperature is below zero for 110 days a year, and there is lots of snow. The county was also the home of Korea's first ski resort in 1974.

The next Winter Games will be in Beijing, China in 2022.

Did you know?

South Korea is 14 hours ahead of New York. It's 15 hours ahead of Chicago. It's 17 hours ahead of Los Angeles. It's nine hours ahead of London.

Soohorang is the mascot of the 2018 Winter Olympics. The white tiger is considered to be Korea's guardian animal. "Sooho" means protection in Korean. "Rang" comes from the word for tiger.
