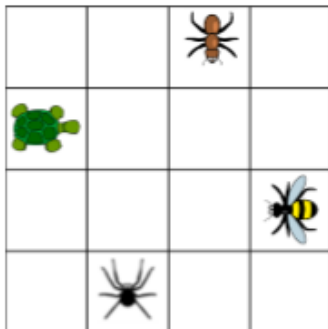
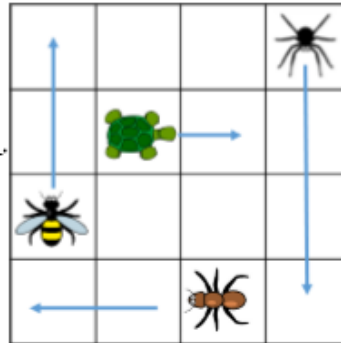

## Pandas

### What do pandas look like?
