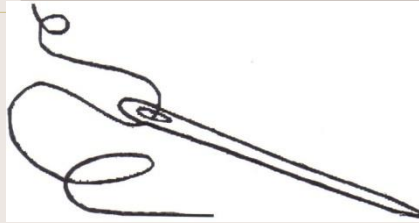

How can I help my child?

- Talk and play - books, shop, journeys, games, memory pairs, dominoes, I-spy etc. Speak clearly and in sentences. "I watch-id the television." "I go-ed to the park."
- Encourage independence and investigation - dressing, toilet/wash hands, trying new activities, new foods, complete a task.
- Maths - counting songs, counting money/toys, sorting, matching, ordering by size etc
- Writing - no capital letters - Joe not JOE? Use the same writing formation.

What do I do if my child is poorly?

Please inform the school by 9.00am by phone, email, or in person, if your child is unwell and unable to attend school. If we have no reason for the absence by 9.30am the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. We will telephone/text parents if your child is absent from school and we have not received notification. Please also notify us if your child has a medical appointment.

We can administer calpol and/or antibiotics with your permission if you require.

Attendance

Parents have a responsibility to ensure that their children receive full time education. Regular attendance is essential if children are to progress with their learning.

We aim for all of our children to have 100% attendance.

Punctuality

Term Time Holidays

From June 2013, school's no longer have any authority to authorise absence for a family holiday during term time. Any such absence is unauthorised. There are a small number of very exceptional circumstances when a holiday absence may be granted. The exceptional circumstances agreed by the Local Authority and Governing Body for Stoneferry Primary for authorising holidays in term time are:

Families who have a parent in the Forces and other employees who are prevented from taking holidays outside term time.

Acute crisis within the family, where the family needs to spend time together to support each other.

Other justified exceptional circumstances.

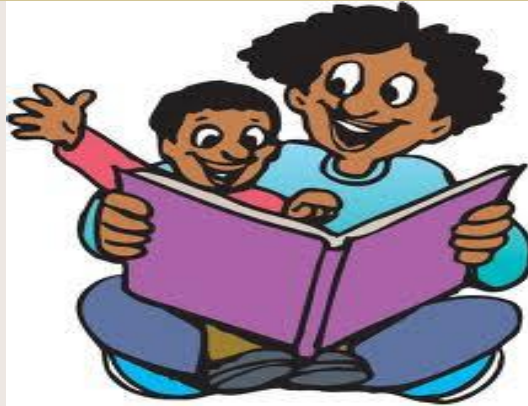

What are Free School Meals?

Many of our families could get Free School Meals but do not claim for them; your child may be entitled to Free School Meals for the duration of their time at Primary School. If you as the parent are in receipt of any of the following benefits you could be eligible:
