Dear Parent

As you will be aware at the start of the school year we made the decision that staff and parents would not be required to wear face coverings as we had other protective measures in place throughout school. We are now changing our protocols regarding this as a result of the changing COVID picture and guidance from the Local Authority and the Hull Learning Partnership. I would like to make it clear to parents that this change is a preventative one and that no parent should have concerns about this change or the current picture in our school. We have not had any cases of COVID in our school.

From Monday, all adults in school will be wearing a face covering when moving around school and in communal areas. Face coverings will not be worn once teachers and children are in their classroom bubbles in order that staff can clearly communicate with their class.

From Monday 21<sup>st</sup> September, parents will also be required to wear a face covering when on school premises in order to keep other parents safe and also to protect our school staff. Please remember to keep at least 2m apart from all other parents and from school staff when on school premises.

Please speak to your child over the weekend about what to expect and that they may see some adults wearing these next week but it is nothing to worry about - teachers will not be wearing these in the classrooms.
