Maths	Please see the Maths links provided for our present Unit of work, which is addition and subtraction. Each lesson has a video that will explain what work is being completed on each day and an exercise to complete. The school office will inform you which lesson you should start from.
Reading	A fiction text has been provided, which is in-line with your child's current phonic stage. Please read the book carefully with your child and work through the questions at the back. Verbal responses at this stage are acceptable, but your child could also be asked to draw and label the answer to these questions. In addition, please try to read as often as you can and complete your reading journal. Reading Rocket stickers will be awarded on return to school.
Writing	<p>In class this week we will be looking at <i>We're Going On a Lion Hunt</i> by David Axtell. This is a retelling of Michael Rosen's classic <i>We're Going On A Bear Hunt</i>. Sequence the pictures from the story in the order they appear and write a sentence together about the picture.</p>
SPAG	2 exercises have been provided which will complement the genre of writing your child will be completing. One is a cut and stick activity where your child will need to sequence the images and attach the correct phrase i.e. picture of grass and swish swash. Ask your child to add 'sound buttons' to aid their reading of the phrase. The other activity A caption activity has also been attached for

	consolidation purposes. Look as the four images, write the phrase that complements the images.
Foundation Subjects	<p>An activity has been provided which the children will be completing in class. This activity is a science based one whereby your child needs to keep a weekly weather chart. You should comment on the type of weather experienced and draw the relevant symbol. Further to this, attached is four trees which have labels: Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter. You child will need to colour the relevant leaves on the tree to display the season.</p> <p>Additionally your child may wish to complete research on African animals to support work in Science, Geography and Art.
