Maths	<p>Daily Quick Starts are attached to be completed in Home Learning books. You do not need to print out the sheet, but please complete answers in your home learning book</p> <p>Please see the Maths links provided for our present Unit of work, which is Addition & Subtraction. Each lesson has a video that will explain what work is being completed on each day and an exercise to complete.</p> <p>Monday 2nd November – Lesson 1 Add and subtract 1s, 10s, 100s and 1000s.</p> <p>Tuesday 3rd November – Lesson 2 Add two 3-digit numbers – not crossing 10 or 100.</p> <p>Wednesday 4th November – Lesson 3 Add two 4-digit numbers – no exchange.</p> <p>Thursday 5th November – Lesson 4 Add two 3-digit numbers – crossing 10 and 100.</p> <p>Friday 6th November – Lesson 5 Add two 4-digit numbers – one exchange.</p> <p>All work to be completed in home learning book.</p>
Spelling	<p>Spellings have also been provided to practise daily and to be tested by an adult on Friday.</p> <p>This week's spelling rule is -sion or -tion.</p> <p>The suffix with the /shun/ sound can be spelled in two ways: -sion and -tion. Root words ending in 't' or 'te' lose these final letters and have the suffix -tion added. Root words ending in 'de', 'd' or 'se' lose these final letters and have the suffix -sion added.</p> <p>Please see attached sheet to support work on this spelling rule.</p> <p>A set of common exception words for your child's class have also been attached to practise.</p>
Reading	<p>Two short non-fiction texts and questions have been provided.</p> <p>Spotting a Tsunami The Official Safe-Tea Shelter</p> <p>Also, please try to read as often as you can and complete your reading journal. Reading Rocket stickers will be awarded on return to school.</p> <p>Finally, we would like you to write a short summary of your current book too.</p>

<p>Writing</p>	<p>In class this week we will be writing a non-chronological report about Life in the Stone Age. This is linked to the topic work where children will need to research what it was like to live in during the Stone Age (Please see Foundation Subject Task).</p> <p>Choose two of the following to research; When was the Stone Age? What was the Stone Age? Where did Stone Age people live? What did Stone Age people eat? What was a Stone Age family like? What did Stone Age people do during the day?
