## RE Autumn Term 2: Week 4

- 1. Warm up: Discuss with the children how they celebrate festivals such as Christmas with their family and within the religious community at their place of worship.
- 2. Explore and discuss how it promotes a sense of belonging and look at the rituals involved such as gift giving, special food, music, dance, singing and worship at Christmas. What examples can they think of?
  - 3. Consider the use and meaning of symbols and artefacts that a believer from two or three different faiths may wear, own or carry associated with a particular celebration or festival
