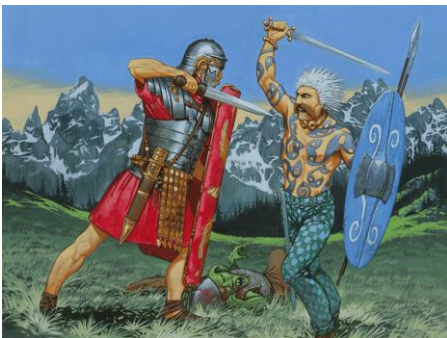


LO: To apply abstract nouns (feelings/ emotions) in my writing.
