Stoneferry Primary School will:

1. Care for your child's well being and safety

Parents/Carers will:

1. Make sure their child arrives at school on time at 8:50 and is collected on time at 3.00 pm
2. Make sure they read with their child 3 times per week.
3. Support the school's Homework Policy, help their child with any work and complete all work on time as requested
4. Make sure their child attends regularly and provide an explanation if the child is absent.
5. Ensure that family holidays are taken out of term time and arrange, wherever possible for medical appointments to be taken out of school hours.
6. Attend all meetings to discuss their child's progress
7. Support our values, encourage positive behaviour and accept responsibility for tackling poor behaviour
8. Keep the school informed of any changes in the family circumstances and ensure the school contact details are correct.
9. Encourage and help their child to participate fully in all school activities as far as possible
10. Provide named uniform for their child, including a kit for PE, a book bag and outdoor clothing suitable for the weather.
11. Approach the school in a positive and respectful manner to resolve any issues.
12. Behave in a supportive, non- aggressive manner when supporting the school in competitive sports.
13. Support all the school policies to create a fair and just society.
14. Abide by the visitors' code of conduct.

Use of the Internet and Social Media:

1. All parents are invited to join staff in setting a good example for our children by ensuring that children's viewing and gaming is age appropriate so that children do not bring dangerous or inappropriate ideas into school.
