Below are a few reminders, so please do take a time to read through the letter. Thank you!




Reminder- school starts at 8:45am with the school gates opening at 8:35am and children have until 8:45am to get into school. At 8:55am the gates are closed and the children arriving after this time, must go to the school office. School closes at 3:15pm with the school gates opening at 3:10pm. For safety reasons, may we politely remind parents/carers that children should not play on the school play equipment either before or after school.













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It is important that your child arrives at school on time. Being 5 mins late each day over a school year equates to 3 days lost. This helps them learn good timekeeping and reduces the chance of classroom disruption, embarrassment and awkwardness.



ALL ABSENCES from school require a telephone call to the school before 9am on the morning of each day's absence. By calling every day, we can be sure of your child's whereabouts and that they are safe. Please do not wait for the office to phone you.



Although it is not necessary to have school branded uniform, all uniform should adhere to the school colours. Please ensure all clothing and water bottles are clearly named because we appreciate how expensive they are, and we want to be able to return any found items. Just to remind you PE kits must be left in school everyday and will come home at October half term, unless it becomes dirty before then.



Just a reminder, breakfast club is now open from 7:30am and after school club closes at 5pm Mon-Thursday and 4:30pm on a Friday. This is to help support working parents, but please ensure you book at least one week in advance. If you require any further information, please contact the office.



School dinners must be ordered at least one week in advance.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2: school meals are free.


Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6: the cost of a school meal will be £1.50 unless you are entitled to Free School Meals.













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We are asking you to please monitor all food items that your child(ren) are bringing to school. Since we have students with life threatening allergies, we must continue to be diligent in not allowing these food products in our school. Thank you for your attention to this important matter.



Just to clarify water bottles are accessible at all times throughout the day but they will be stored in a box rather than on their desk. This is to prevent equipment getting damaged. Water bottles will now go out with the children at lunch and playtime to ensure children remain hydrated.




This year we have signed up to Seesaw, more information will be given to you regarding Seesaw this week, but one of the features will allow a two way messaging systems between teachers and parents.


